JESUS IN EXODUS

- 1. Eisegesis** Is a Fancy Way of Referring to The Act of Reading Our Own Thoughts into The Scriptures. Why Do You Think We're So Often Tempted to Read Our Own Ideas into The Scriptures. What Are Some Things That We Can Do to Avoid This Error?

- 2. Ethnicity** Is Another Common Error Whereby Individuals Read Their Particular Group into The Scripture to Suggest That Their Group Is Superior to Others. For Instance, Whites Over Blacks; Blacks Over Whites, Men Over Women; etc. This Is the Ungodly Error That Was Used by European Colonizers to Justify African Slavery. Today, We See the Same Ungodly Error Giving Rise to Groups Such as The Black Israelites. Why Are We So Prone to Believing That the Text Places Our Group Above Others and How Do We Avoid This Ungodly and Divisive Error?

- 3.** In Exodus Jesus Is Pictured as Our Deliverer, Our Passover Lamb, Our Manna, Our Rock, Our Tabernacle, And Our High Priest. Of These Types Which Ones Speak to Your Life and In What Way?
